Subject: Requiring the General Assembly to adjourn no later than April 30 in any session.

PROPOSAL 6

Sec. 1. PURPOSE

This proposal would amend the Vermont Constitution to require the General Assembly to adjourn no later than April 30 in any session.

Sec. 2. Section 7 of Chapter II of the Vermont Constitution is amended to read:

§7. [BIENNIAL SESSIONS]

The General Assembly shall meet biennially on the first Wednesday next after the first Monday of January, beginning in A. D.1915.

Any session of the General Assembly which convenes in January shall adjourn for such year no later than April 30, except that it may reconvene thereafter for a session of no more than three consecutive days to consider vetoes of any bills submitted to the governor, if any.
